Convention Summary – Paige

USMS Convention was held in Atlanta, GA Sept. 24-28, 2008 and Paige served as the Inland NW delegate.

- A. Rule Changes
 - 1. Club scoring (104.5.6 & .7C): now Regional Clubs scored separately from Local Clubs
 - 2. Wetsuits for open water swims now have an upper temperature threshold of 78 deg F. (303.6.3)
 - 3. Wetsuits at open water nat'l championships will continue to be excluded for records & club scoring but there will no longer need to be a separate finish line for those who wish to wear them.
- B. Rob Butcher hired as new USMS Executive Director
 - 1. Rob has some ambitious goals for USMS growth. He published a vision plan prior to convention to lay these out. The most financially impactful to our group is the idea to increase the USMS portion of our fees by \$2/yr each year from 2010 to 2018 and charging \$20 per workout group.
